Former Everton & England Goalkeeper

Nicknamed 'The Boss' for his long Everton Service. Ted Sagar was capped for both England (and Northern Ireland during World War 2)

The First Goalkeeper in History to wear the Jersey Number One.

Established a One Club Service Record, for his time at Everton.

Decisive in his Judgement, when he dealt with Shot or Cross.

Shouted orders at Defenders, so they nicknamed him 'The Boss'.

A Star in the Great Thirties Team, such a dependable Custodian

Great Agility, Skill and Courage, from this Everlasting Evertonian.

A top England International, who played for Northern Ireland too.

Robbed of many further Honours by six years of World War Two.
